On behalf of Burnett Oil Co., Inc., this notice is to inform you of our intent to submit an Army Corps Section 404 Joint Permit Application to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (hereinafter referred to as PADEP).

Project Description: The project involves the construction of a 400' x 400' unconventional well pad to be used for oil and gas exploration and production. A 16-foot wide permanent access road will be constructed beginning approximately 0.36 miles west of Wymps Gap Road/ S.R. 3004, ending at the proposed well pad. The permanent access road will be approximately 3,150 feet in length. The entire project area is approximately 13.8 acres and consists primarily of meadow and wooded area with thick brush. All disturbed areas will be stabilized and seeded upon construction completion.

"If you wish to submit comments for DEP to consider in a land use review of this project, you must respond within 30 days to the DEP regional office listed below. If there are no land use comments received by the end of the comment period, DEP will assume that there are no substantive land use conflicts and proceed with the normal application review process."
